Make the block of the month according to the directions (colors of your choice) and bring it to the meeting. A ticket will be given for each block submitted. The winning ticket will receive a prize. Blocks will be placed on a table for all to see BUT THEN the blocks will be taken home by the maker and saved until all 12 are made.

Option 1: Make a quilt from the 12 blocks arranged as desired (with or without sashing, borders, etc.)
These quilts will be displayed at next year’s guild show.

Option 2: Make as many or as few blocks as desired and use them to make runners, wall hangings, small quilt, etc. to be displayed at the show.

Option 3: Make as many or as few blocks as desired and donate them to the guild. Hopefully volunteers will assemble them so they can be hung in the show.

Option 4: Trade with other Guild members.

Completed quilts can then remain the property of the quilter or be auctioned off as a fund raising activity.
